Re: Amendments to the Engineering Profession Act and Proposal for Meeting

The Chamber of Engineers requests an update on the revised amendments to the Engineering Act comprising the revisions proposed by the Chamber following consultation with its members and which have been agreed upon with the Engineering Profession Board following our discussions during the past months. As previously advised, our understanding is that the Board has forwarded these draft amendments to the relevant European Commission entity for endorsement. Has this step in the process started and were there any developments? The introduction of the definition of “Inginier”, the revision of the definition of “Engineering services” to align with “practice of engineering” definition (L.N.354of2012) as well as the revision of the title to “Inginiera Act”, remain the most keenly requested changes by the engineering community. The above describes the reasons behind why such an important update needs to be communicated .

Furthermore the Chamber takes this opportunity to request a formal meeting with the Engineering Profession Board following the appointment of the new board members. The Chamber anticipates to discuss the developments and next steps on the Engineering Act amendments as well as the MCAST course review process.

Thanks in advance for your availability. The Chamber looks forward to keep executing a key function to influence decisions for the advancement of our profession and engineers.
